At the Sigulda Arts School "Grand Piano" from July 12 - 21, 2023, young musicians worldwide will again have the opportunity, during vocal, instrumental, chamber music, composition, music pedagogy and choral conducting masterclasses, to acquire new knowledge and create new collaborations, as well as hone their professional mastery in master classes under the direction of outstanding musicians and teaching artists. At the XV Master Courses, the new directions and sources of inspiration that are forming and influencing the music scene in Latvia and the world today will be emphasized in lectures, master classes and concerts. As is always the case at the Master Courses, the music of Latvian composers will be an important part of the program.

- (3 x a day) and lodging. Transportation costs will not be covered. For participants, who will not require lodging or meals: EUR 80. A 50% advance payment is required by 31.05.2023; the remainder to be paid by 30.06.2023. A bill will be sent after the receipt of the Application form.

Repertoire information: Simultaneously with the registration for the XV Master Courses, participants (instrumentalists and vocalists) should submit a list of 4 prepared pieces of different periods and styles, including one by a Latvian composer by email to: muzika@baltaisfligelis.lv Composers are requested to send one or two representative pieces to Gundega Šmite by 1.06.2023: gundega.smite@jvlma.lv Composers should also bring scores and recordings of their works to the Master Courses. During the Master Courses composers will have the opportunity to compose a work for various combinations of string instruments. In Dimitris Maronidis' classes, students will be introduced to the main principles of electroacoustic music and recording technology. Each participant will receive a Certificate of Participation in the XV Master Courses.

Fourteen Master Courses have been organized biennially in Latvia: 1994 in Jaungulbene; 1996, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2008 in Ogre; 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016, 2018 and 2021 (virtually) in Sigulda. Approximately 1,800 participants and master artists/teachers have attended the Master Courses, since they first began in Latvia in 1994.
